- BJCA is delighted to offer a series of 3 training events in the 2018/19 season.
- These will be given by Andrew Martin IM @ Yateley Manor School¹ (51 Reading Road, Yateley, GU46 7UQ). They will take place on the above dates between 0930-1330.
- Though teaching will be (at least initially) in one group, it will be pitched at a level that will be useful for upper board county players as well as appropriately challenging for mid and lower board players.
- Cost: £15 for each session payable via Paypal on the BJCA website (www.bjca.org.uk) up to 7 days before the event. £25 thereafter including on the day. BJCA is attempting to run the events on a cost neutral basis.
- **Places are limited** – therefore please contact training@bjca.org.uk if you are thinking of turning up on the day to avoid disappointment.
- Should more entrants sign up for the training than there are places, BJCA reserves the right either to refund those entrants that entered after the quota had been filled, or to arrange additional trainers to cater for such over-subscription.
- BJCA training sessions are open to anyone aged under 18 at midnight on August 31st 2018 and who is either resident in, or attends a school in, Berkshire or adjoining county.
- As no parents' room is provided, parents will not be able to wait during the training.
