

Introduction

After very positive feedback from last year's training events, BJCA is pleased to offer a schedule of three Saturday morning junior chess training events for the year 2013/14. Two of the training events will precede an SAE taking place at the same venue. The three ability groups will ensure all ranges of abilities, from the less experienced to strong county players will be accommodated.

The training will again be run by trainers from the Institute of Chess (IoC), and experienced professional trainers including a FIDE senior trainer. Group 1 will learn IoC Level 2-3 principles, and Group 2 Level 3-4 principles. Group 3 will be more advanced and less structured, but will generally correspond to Level 4 and beyond. Optional IoC exams will also be offered at the end of Sessions 2 and 3.

Training Costs
